Action Required

The Committee is invited to approve the replacement of Soudelor which was removed from the list of tropical cyclone names.

Replacement Name for Soudelor

Super Typhoon Soudelor made a direct hit on the island of Saipan in the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands on 2 August 2015 as a category 4 typhoon. Soudelor was a very small system, with a 5-mile diameter eye, typhoon force winds extending no more than 10 miles from the center, and tropical storm force wind extended no more than 20 miles from the center. While causing extensive island wide damage to infrastructures and utilities, there were no deaths. After Saipan, Soudelor briefly became a category 5 super typhoon before making landfall in Taiwan in the morning of 8 August 2015, and in the Fujian Province of China later that evening. Soudelor also impacted portions of the Ryukyu Islands of Japan on 7-8 August 2015. In the 48^h session of the Typhoon Committee, the request to retire the name Soudelor was approved. In response to this request, U.S.A. suggests the following names as replacements for Soudelor.
