1. Background

The Committee approved the Long-Term Mechanism for TC Secretary Appointment in its 49th session held in Yokohama, Japan, from 21 to 24 February 2017.

Mr. YU Jixin was confirmed by the Typhoon Committee, in its 47th session held in Bangkok, Thailand, from 9 to 13 February 2015, as Secretary of this Committee for the period 2015-2018/early 2019.
